SPECIAL PARISH GENERAL ASSEMBLY - SUNDAY, DECEMBER 10, 2000

A special General Assembly of Saint Spyridon Cathedral has been requested by a signed petition from parishioners who wish to discuss the Air Conditioning project "previously approved by the General Assembly". It will be held on Sunday, December 10, 2000 at 12:30 p.m., in the Cotsidas Auditorium.

 - a. June 8, 1997 - General Assembly minutes:
 - "Penny Ann McClaren moved that our facilities be air conditioned and that the Parish Council present at the next General Assembly the appropriation request with how the moneys are to be raised. Seconded by Steve Maminakis.
 - "An amendment to the motion was made by James Bazoukas that the funding for the air conditioning be by appropriation of \$100,000 from the Grecian Festival credit line established for Holy Trinity Nursing Home which will be available to us in late August and the other \$150,000 balance be raised through a major capital fund drive. Accepted by Penny Ann McClaren the motion was seconded by Aris Felis. After further discussion Angie Michaelides moved the question. The motion was passed."
 - b. November 12, 2000 - General Assembly minutes (draft):
 - Loukia Bitzas motioned that the Project be funded as to Proposal #1. Presvytera Cynthia seconded the motion. A discussion followed. George Fotiades proposed an amendment to Loukia Bitzas' motion, which was accepted, and is as follows:

\$ 4,000 from the Endowment Fund
\$ 18,000 from the Bellos' Fund Interest
\$ 118,000 from Capital Improvement Fund
\$ 45,000 from Grecian Festival Fund
\$ 185,000 Total
\$ 10,000 from returning excess house funds
\$ 20,000 in understood donation for the A/C project

For a total of: \$ 215,000 to cover the increased cost of the A/C project
 - "A vote was taken: 39 hands rose for the Project: 6 hands rose in opposition; no hands raised in dissention. The Assembly moved to have the Parish Council move as soon as possible on the project."
