 - a. Motion to establish a Youth/Senior Center Building Fund. The newly established Youth/Senior Center Building Committee and the Parish Council shall use these funds only for the planning and building of the Youth/Senior Center project to be located on existing Cathedral owned property. All net proceeds from events and/or donations, gifts and grants designated for this project shall be placed into this fund account. During the term of this project, funds are to be overseen by the Investment Committee in conjunction with the Youth/Senior Center Building Committee. If ground breaking of Youth/Senior Center building has not begun prior to December 31, 2015, then all remaining funds will be reallocated into the Endowment Fund.
 - b. Motion to approve the allowance of capital for a second priest by January 2005. Estimated amount of an additional \$35,000.00 for the hiring of second priest or deacon.
 - c. Motion to approve a Balanced Budget Amendment to the By-Laws requiring that no funds shall be deposited into the Endowment Funds, until the Parish Council submits and the General Assembly approves a Balanced Budget, except if a gift, bequest or contribution is specifically designated for the Fund by a donor.
 - d. Motion to approve an amendment to the By-Laws making the quorum of the General Assembly no less than fifty (50) parishioners in good standing.
