  - a) **Motion to approve the Family Center conceptual design, which has been reviewed and approved by the building committee and parish council.**
  - b) **Motion to approve the Parish Council, Building Committee and Capital Campaign Committee to fund raise \$ 8 to \$ 12 million for the construction of the family center.**
  - c) **Motion to approve the Building Committee supplemental budget for fundraising and on going project operations, for the remainder of 2005 attached hereto as Exhibit A.**
  - d) **Motion to amend Section III Item C of the Cathedral By-Laws to read; *"The General Assembly shall not appropriate any fund at a regular special meeting other than the Annual Meeting, unless notice of the purpose for which said money is to be spent and the amount estimated to be needed is listed in the call of the meeting. All Parish Council or General Assembly committees must present a detailed budget for any project or program to be submitted and approved by the Parish Council and the General Assembly."***
  - e) **Motion to amend section I to read, *"Effective January 1, 1987, the Saint Spyridon Greek Orthodox Cathedral Parish shall adopt the Christian Stewardship (Fair Share) program, with a required minimum of \$475.00 per family and \$325.00 per single or senior couple, (single to be defined as 21 years and older; seniors is defined as 65 years and older). Annual increases shall be calculated by the Consumer Price Index."***
  - f) **Motion to appropriate \$9,881.00 from The Endowment Interest Fund for the purchase of a new copier.**
