

Proposal for General Assembly

New dues structure contingent on adoption of Total Commitment.

Article VI

Section 1: Any person, eighteen years of age or over, who was baptized according to the rites of the Church, or was received into the Church through chrismation, who lives according to the faith and canons of the Church, abides by the regulations herein and by the by-laws of the Parish, is a member in good standing of the Parish, except that persons under twenty-one shall not serve on the Parish Council when such service is contrary to local law.

Article VI

Section 7: The obligations of a parishioner are to pay such regular membership dues and special assessments as the Parish Assembly may establish, and to meet such Archdiocesan financial charges as may be fixed by the Biennial Assembly.

Parishioner (male or female)\$100.00
Spouse of Parishioner\$ 50.00
Single person, living at home\$ 50.00
Student (full-time) exempt unless he or she wishes to participate in Church administration or act as sponsor.
Senior Parishioners (as stated in General Assembly by-laws.)\$ 40.00 annually.

There are no other categories or exceptions. A Parishioner, however, having financial difficulty, may consult with the Priest and President of the Parish Council for possible revision.
