The General Assembly of Saint Spyridon Greek Orthodox Community was called to order at 12:45 p.m. by Helen Panagiotou, President.

Father Nicholas Krommydas offered the opening prayer. There was a quorum of 48 members present.

Nicholas Bazoukas was elected to chair the meeting.

Nicholas Bazoukas thanked Helen Panagiotou for her tenure and president.

The members of the assembly were given time to review the Stewardship proposal.

- A. Family Membership, including husband and wife and all children through the age of 18 years of age. Full-time students to the age of 25 shall be considered as members of the family. Both husband and wife shall have full voting privileges and membership status.
 - B. Single Parent, Head of Household with only one spouse, and including all children to the age of 18. Full time students to the age of 25 shall be considered as member under this category.
 - C. Individual Member -- An individual not eligible as a member of a family or a single parent household.
 - D. Senior Family -- A family in which the husband or wife is over 65 years of age.
 - E. Senior Member -- An individual over 65 years of age.
2. All members of Saint Spyridon Cathedral shall contribute towards the Church an amount in accordance with their means, provided, however, that the amount shall not be less than the following:
- a. Family -- \$275.00 minimum
 - b. Single Parent -- \$150.00 minimum
 - c. Individual -- \$150.00 minimum
 - d. Senior Family -- \$150.00 minimum
 - e. Senior Individual -- \$100.00 minimum

- f. Student -- \$50.00 minimum (with voting privileges)
3. The Dean of the Cathedral of the President of the Parish Council may waive at their/his sole discretion any minimum stewardship amount upon request by any member because of financial circumstances of the member. This decision shall be final and confidential and shall not be subject to review.

Emmanuel Miliias moved the adoption of the entire proposal. Seconded by Donald Theoharides.

Discussion ensued. Concerns raised:

1. Will this proposal cover the \$48,000.00 deficit.
2. Will the minimum become the maximum?
3. A census is needed.
4. There is a need statistics to show structural make up of the parish.
5. Logistically this program is a horror.
6. What type of follow up program is needed?
7. Would we require an annual cost of living increase?

Nickolas Moudios wants to go on record as being opposed to this proposal.

It was moved and seconded to table the motion. In a vote 22 to 15 the motion was tabled.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:35 p.m.
