

The General Assembly of Saint Spyridon Greek Orthodox Community was called to order at 8:15 p. m. by the President of the Board of Directors, Dr. Harry Pappas. Rev. Solon Tsandikos offered the Opening Prayer.

The minutes of the previous General Assembly were read and approved with proper corrections.

The President, Dr. Pappas, presented an interim report of the activities and accomplishments of the community for the past six months.

The Treasurer, Paul Tsourides, rendered the financial report of the community as of June 28, 1971. As of this date 239 members have paid regular dues for 1971 and 66 members have paid \$100.00 or more for 1971.

Gregory Zekos presented a report on the Youth and the Youth Center of our Community.

George Liacos, co-chairman of the House Committee recommended that four trees that are dead or dying be removed from our property at 72 Cedar Street.

George Botsis made a motion that \$500.00 be withdrawn from the 12% Maintenance Account for the purpose of the removal of the four trees as recommended by the House Committee. Seconded by Chris Lekas.

Arthur Lagadinos amended the motion to add that at least three bids be acquired by the House Committee before the job is done.

The amended motion was passed.

Theodore Singas made a motion that an admission of \$1.00 for anyone over 15 years of age be charged at our church picnic in the future. Seconded by Charles K. Davis with the ammendment that the age limit be raised to 18 years.

Chris Dionis recommends that the motion on the admission price of \$1.00 per for the annual church picnic be placed on the Agenda for the next General Assembly. The motion was passed.

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Nicholas Drapos made a motion that the term of service by an individual on the Board of Directors be limited to two consecutive terms or four years. After a lapse of two years said individual is to be allowed to run again. The effective date of this requirement would begin with the fiscal year of our church, October 1, 1971, and would be in effect during the December, 1971, Board elections. Seconded by James Statson and passed.

Thomas Efthimiou made a motion that the number of members of the Board of Directors be reduced to eleven (11) members. Seconded by Names Drapos. The motion was defeated.

Peter Bell recommends that the above motion be placed on the Agenda for the next General Assembly. Recommendation refused.
