

SPECIAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY, SUNDAY, AUGUST 20, 1995

The Special General Assembly of the Saint Spyridon Greek Orthodox Cathedral was called to order at 11:15 A. M. By the President of the Parish Council, Chris Dionis. There were 46 members (a quorum) present

The President, thanked everyone for being in attendance and the General Assembly approved his serving as Chairperson.

Before addressing the one agenda item, Chris Dionis announced that the Parish Council, within its jurisdiction, has made arrangements and appropriated moneys, not to exceed \$5000.00 from the Insurance Fund Account to repair plaster area right side and rear of the Cathedral as well as the choir loft.

Al Matulaitis, House Committee Chairman, explained the need for additional pointing, caulking and repairs to various parts the Community Center and the belfry of the Cathedral. It is noted here that four bids were received.

Maureen O'Connell, President of the Folan Waterproofing & Construction Company, Inc. detailed the various structural problems in need of repairs and answered questions from the floor.

President Dionis presented the request for "an appropriation of funds not to exceed \$6000.00 from the Grecian Festival Account for additional pointing, caulking, and repairs to stonework of the Community Center and water damage to the belfry of the Cathedral."

Emmanuel Miliias moved the adoption of the proposal as presented. Aris Felis seconded. The motion was passed with no objections.

The meeting was concluded at 11:55 p. m.
